Jerrold B. Everson, 84, of Berlin, husband of Margaretha Krattinger Everson, passed away Tuesday November 20, 2012 at Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. A New Britain native, he lived in New Britain and Plainville most of his life, moving to Berlin in 2000. He was a member of New Britain High School , Class of 1946, he served with the US Army in Germany during the Korean Conflict. Jerry operated Everson's TV on Main Street in New Britain with his brother Elbert for 50 years, retiring in 2000. He was a member of the former Trinity United Methodist Church in New Britain; and was a member and former Permittee of the Liederkrantz Club in Newington.
