November 27, 1925 - January 29, 2003

Joan Jones Abraham, 77, of New Britain, died unexpectedly Wednesday January 29, 2003 at her home. She was the widow of Benjamin J. Abraham, who died February 16, 1991. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, she was the daughter of the late Deacon Yonan and Shalim Jones. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1943, she worked with her brother at Friendly Jewelers in New Britain for 18 years, retiring in 1983. She then worked for 7 years at the former New Britain National Bank, later Fleet Bank. Joan was a member of St. Thomas Assyrian Church in New Britain and was a longtime volunteer in the Pathology Department at New Britain General Hospital, where she was named "volunteer of the year" in 2001.

Surviving are her 2 beloved daughters, Marion A. Carey and her husband Stephen of New Britain; Margaret Abraham and Alfred Akowitz of Old Saybrook; a brother, Jonathan Jones and his wife Doris of Glastonbury; 3 grandchildren, the joy of her life, Stephen B. Carey, Elizabeth Carey, and Stella Carey; 3 nieces, Christine Massi of Southington; Marlene Jones of Plainville; and Diane Abraham of New Britain; a special cousin, Howard Isaac of New Britain, and a host of other friends. She was loved by all who knew her.
