Joanne (DeNigris) Pfeuffer, 61, of Ravenel, SC, passed away Friday (December 29, 2023) at Summerville Medical Center in Summerville, SC. Born in New Britain, daughter of Atty. Nicholas E. DeNigris and Patricia (Harris) DeNigris, of New Britain, she was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1980 and Pace University in New York. Joanne was a resident of South Carolina for over 15 years and previously lived in Laconia, NH for 20 years. She operated White Oak Farm in Laconia where she raised horses and then Southern Oak Farm and Southern Oak Rescue (for animals) in Ravenel. A lifelong lover of animals, Joanne won the CT English Riding Championship at age 16.

Besides her parents Nick and Pat, she leaves a son, Travis Pfeuffer and his wife Christen of Hollywood, SC and their son, Elliott Pfeuffer; a sister, Rosemarie Sirois and her husband Brian of Argyle, Texas; two nieces, Alexis Steckley and her husband Kieran and Kristin Hensley and her husband Craig, all in Texas; and several cousins.

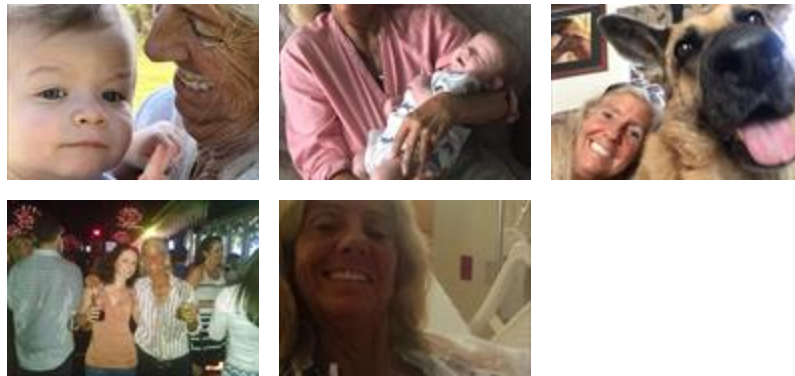
