John Bielski, 78, of New Britain, died Monday December 4, 2006 at Hospital of Central Connecticut. He was the widower of Lena Poncini Bielski, who died in 2003. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, he worked for many years at TRW in Plainville and later worked briefly at Creed-Monarch in New Britain until his retirement.
