John E. Bores, 95, of Southington, husband of the late Marjorie Crum Bores, passed away Wednesday November 4, 2015 at the Jerome Home in New Britain. A New Britain native, he lived in Southington for the past 63 years. John was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1938 and attended Hillyer College in Hartford. He served with the US Merchant Marine during World War II and was employed in the Stanley Works Steel Division for 38 years, retiring in 1984.
