John D. Hair, 78, of New Britain, widower of Nina Burak Hair, died Thursday June 14, 2007 at the Masonic Health Center in Wallingford. Born in New Haven, he lived in New Britain since 1960. A graduate of Hillhouse High School, John was a WWII US Army veteran. He was a metrologist at Fafnir Bearing Company for 30 years, retiring in 1992. He was a member of First Church of Christ, Congregational in New Britain; was a three time Master of the former Walnut Hill Lodge, #139 AF&AM, where he also served as a Past District Deputy; was presently a member of Unity Lodge #148, AF&AM; was both a Scottish Rite and York Rite 32nd Degree Mason; and was a member of the Fellowcraft Club and New Britain VFW Post 511.

Surviving is his son, William Hair and his wife Kim of Bristol; a sister, Isabel Haesche of Branford; two cousins, Virginia Rossotto and Helen Pettruzelli, both of Hamden; and two nephews, Alan and Bryan Haesche.
