John Roger Pelto, 77, died Tuesday September 10, 2002 after a long illness. Born January 31, 1925 in Detroit, Michigan, son of the late John Rickard Pelto and Lola Fortier Pelto Sheridan, he moved to Kensington where he was a resident for the past 51 years. John served in WWII in the 26th Yankee Division in Germany and was a Purple Heart recipient in the Battle of the Bulge.
