



## Josephine Kereleyza Paluch

August 8, 1914 - June 1, 2006

Josephine Kereleyza Paluch, 91, of New Britain, wife of Matthew S. Paluch, born on August 8, 1914, daughter of the late Nicholas and Helen Gerent Kereleyza, died Thursday June 1, 2006 at New Britain General Hospital. A lifelong New Britain resident, she graduated from New Britain High School, Class of 1931, operated Helen's Candy Store also known as Blondies on the corner of North and Tremont St. Later worked for Doctor Richmond, a local Orthodontist, until her retirement in 1976. Josephine was an active member of St. Mary's Ukrainian Orthodox Church; a member of St. Olga Sisterhood; and sang in the church choir.
