



Josephine Celile Schrager

June 5, 1921 - January 7, 2002

Josephine "Jo" Schultz Schrager, 80, of Newington died Monday Jan. 7, 2002 in Southington. She was the widow of Donald Schrager, who died in 1999. Born in New Rochelle, NY, she was a former New Britain resident moving to Newington in 1946. A WWII Army Air Corps veteran, she was with the 110th Army Air Force Unit. Mrs. Schrager was employed at the former Prentice Mfg. and later at Lehrer's Hardware for 10 years, retiring in 1967. She was a member of St. Matthew's Lutheran Church in New Britain; the Mr. & Mrs. Club of the church; and helped with the hot lunch program at St. Matthew's Lutheran School. She was also a member of VFW Post 511 in New Britain; the Newington Volunteer Fire Dept. Auxillary; the Donau Austrian Singing Society; and was a Brownie and Girl Scout troop leader in Newington.

Surviving are 2 daughters, Donna Martin and her husband Romeo of Plainville; Jo Ann Battistoni of Morris; 3 grandsons, Michael Battistoni of Middletown; Eric and Scott Martin, both of Plainville; several nieces and nephews.
