Joyce Yukins Pasco, 78, of Farmington and Sebastian, Florida, wife of William Pasco, passed away Thursday June 23, 2016 at Lawrence & Memorial Hospital in New London. Born in Brockton, MA, she was a former New Britain resident, moving to Farmington in 1970. A University of Connecticut graduate, where she received a BSRN, she later received an MBA from Rensselaer, the Hartford branch. Joyce was Assistant Director of Nursing at the American Red Cross Group in Farmington, where she worked for 24 years.
