Judith “Judy” (Kerin) Badrigian, 79, of Wethersfield, wife of the late John Badrigian, passed away Tuesday (January 31, 2017) at Hartford Hospital surrounded by her family. Born in Hartford, she lived in New Britain most of her life, moving to Wethersfield in 2008. Judy was daughter of the late Florence (Welsh) Kerin and Russell Kerin, who was Killed in Action in World War II and whom she dearly missed. Judy was raised by her loving aunt, Mary “Mamie” Walsh. 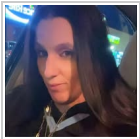

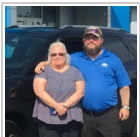
