Judith Wilbur Scalise, 74, of New Britain, beloved wife of Robert "Bob" Scalise, Sr., passed away Thursday December 17, 2014 at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. Born in Boston, MA, daughter of the late Harold and Elizabeth Alywood Wilbur, she grew up in Camden Maine and she has been a New Britain resident since 1962.
