



## Julia Jakubczyk Centurelli

February 12, 1920 - November 29, 2012

Julia Jakubczyk Centurelli, 92, of Plainville, passed away on November 29, 2012. She was the widow of the late Henry "Chick" Centurelli who passed away in 1964. She was the daughter of the late Jan and Maria Wdovik Jakubczyk.

Julia was born in New Britain in 1920, graduated from New Britain High in 1937, and married in New Britain in 1941. She lived in New Britain until 1955 when she moved to Kensington where she worked for New Britain National Bank for over 20 years. Upon the death of Henry, she took over his office as Treasurer of the Berlin Little League and maintained that position for 14 years. She was also the Treasurer of the Berlin Babe Ruth League for 7 years. The Centurelli Field in Berlin is named for her husband.

She was predeceased by 6 sisters, 4 brothers, a son-in-law David Rouelle and daughter-in-law Agnes Piekut Centurelli.
