Julia Kerleyza Lyon, 85, of New Britain, died Sunday February 23, 2003 at New Britain General Hospital. A native and lifelong New Britain resident, she was the daughter of the late Sofron and Katherine Kerleyza. Julia was formerly employed at Pratt & Whitney Aircraft in Hartford; Prentice Manufacturing in Kensington; and later was an assembler at North & Judd Manufacturing, which became Wilcox-Crittendon in Middletown for 25 years, retiring in 1980.
