Kando Eshia, 101, of New Britain, died Friday July 1, 2005 at New Britain General Hospital. She was the widow of Jonathan Eshia, who died in 1991. Born in Desatecha, Iran, she moved to New Britain in 1921. Kando was employed at Fafnir Bearing Company in New Britain for 30 years, retiring in 1969.
