Keenan A. Pindar, 76, of New Britain, husband of Elaine Cyr Pindar, passed away Thursday June 1, 2012 at CT Hospice in Branford. Born in Madison, Maine, he was a former Hartford resident, moving to New Britain in 1967. Keenan was an electrician in the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Union IBEW Local 35 for 50 years, retiring in 2000. He was a member of St. Maurice Church in New Britain; New Britain Elk's Lodge 957; and the Stanley Golf Club Seniors.
