Kirsten Elizabeth Carlson, 33, of Manchester, New Hampshire, died Friday May 5, 2006 at Catholic Medical Center in Manchester. Born in New Britain, she moved to New Hampshire seven years ago. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1990, she was a Teller at the former Federal Savings Bank, owned and operated A Touch of Class nail salon in Rocky Hill, and briefly served as a Deputy Sheriff before moving to New Hampshire.

Surviving is her daughter, Victoria ?Tori? Brennan of Bristol; her parents, Kent and Betsy Grant Carlson of New Britain; her fiance Mark Kenyon of Manchester, New Hampshire; her maternal grandmother, Elizabeth ?Betty?
