Lawrence W. "Larry" Botticelli, 89, of Wilmington, Delaware, died Saturday January 26, 2002 in Wilmington after a short illness. He was the widower of Sophie "Sally" Capetan Botticelli, who died in 1979. Born in New Britain, he lived here most of his life, spent his summers in Avalon, NJ, and moved to Wilmington in July of 2000. A graduate of New Britain High School in 1931, he was a World War II U.S. Army veteran. Larry was employed in the New Britain Post Office for over 25 years, retiring in 1977. He was an avid golfer at the Stanley Golf Club, and in his younger years, was a respected athlete in high school and in the old New Britain Industrial Leagues.

A longtime member of St. Ann's Church, Larry was also a member of the VFW Post 511 in New Britain; the Knights of Columbus; AARP; and the New Britain Senior Citizens.

Surviving is one son, Lawrence J. Botticelli of Westwood, NJ; a daughter, Lorraine Botticelli of Wilmington, DE; a granddaughter, Alexis Botticelli, also of Wilmington; several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services are Friday 9:15 AM at Carlson Funeral Home, 45 Franklin Sq., New Britain, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial 10 AM at St. Ann's Church.
