September 8, 1916 - August 31, 2005

Leno Balducci, 88, of New Britain, died Wednesday August 31, 2005 at his home. Born in Italy, Leno moved to New Britain in 1923 and has also maintained a residence at Coral Sands in Westbrook for many years. He attended local schools and was employed at Fafnir Bearing Company in New Britain for 32 years until his retirement in 1979. Leno was a member of St. Ann's Church, and the Marchegian Society, both of New Britain.
