Leonard R. Pfeiffer, 85, of Kensington, widower of Beverly Stedman Pfeiffer, passed away Monday March 9, 2015 at his home. Born in New Britain, graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1947, Leonard has been a Kensington resident since 1965. A Korean War US Army Veteran, Leonard was employed for the US Postal Service in New Britain for 35 years until his retirement in 1988.
