



## Leonilda "Lee" Napolitano

December 25, 1929 - February 6, 2017

Leonilda "Lee" (Prisco) Napolitano, 87, of Holiday, FL, formerly of New Britain, passed away in Florida, February 6, 2017. She was born in Tufino, Italy, December 25, 1929, to the late Domenico and Orsula (Oreintale) Prisco. She was predeceased by her husband, Angelo Napolitano.

In 1957 she and her husband opened Angelo's Lunch, later known as Angelo's Pizza, on Broad Street in New Britain. In 1969, they opened another pizzeria just down the road, Red Door Pizzeria, which is still in business today. In 1981, Lee and Angelo retired to Holiday. Lee was a member of both St. Ann Church in New Britain, and St. Vincent de Paul Church in Holiday. Lee was also a very proud lifetime member of Weight Watchers.

In addition to her husband, Lee was predeceased by her parents, brother, Domenick "Tony" Prisco, and sisters Rosalie Legere, and Maria Prisco. She is survived by her sons, Frank and his wife Kathleen of New Britain, Dominic and his wife Frances of Clarksville, TN, Angelo and his wife Kasia of Wolcott; seven grandchildren, Frank of Marlborough, Marianna Tanner and her husband Mike of Clarksville, TN, Adam of Berlin, Diana Hodges and her husband Jason of Clarksville, TN, Vanessa of New Britain, Nino and Julia of Wolcott; six great-grandchildren, Saige, Luke, Morgan, Lance, Alyssa, and Avery, a brother-in-law, William Naples of Bristol, several nieces and nephews, and a longtime family friend, Conrad Fabella of San Diego, CA.
