Lois Malmgren, 85, of New York City, passed away Thursday April 8, 2010 at St. Joseph's Medical Center, Yonkers, NY. She was a native of New Britain with a long and colorful career in the performing arts and as a publicist. In the 1950s and early 1960s she hosted a popular TV show on New Haven's WNHC before moving to New York, where she served in executive positions with N W Ayer Advertising, General Foods and Bloomingdales.

Lois received a degree from Bryant College in Rhode Island and worked with the Red Cross during World War II. She was a longtime member of the South Church in New Britain and Christ Church United Methodist in Manhattan.

Surviving are her cousins, Audrey Brown of Southington, Jaye Sepko of Niantic and numerous friends.
