Lois E. "Lo" Foberg Rustico, 76, of Berlin, wife of William "Bill" Rustico, passed away Thursday June 4, 2015 at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. Born in Hartford, she was the daughter of the late Howard and Marion Fuller Foberg, and a former East Berlin, Farmington and East Hartford resident until moving back to Berlin in 2011. A 1957 graduate of New Britain High School, she also graduated from the Middlesex Memorial School of Nursing in 1960 and was a Registered Nurse for Dr. Anthony Nevulis in New Britain.
