Louise Hesse, 98, of Covenant Village, Cromwell, passed away Monday February 17, 2014. Born in New Britain, daughter of the late William and Minnie Mare Hesse, she was a former New Britain and Newington resident, moving to Cromwell in 1989. Louise was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1934, and was employed at Emhart Corporation in Berlin for 27 years, retiring in 1980. She also worked at the CT Baptist Convention Office in Hartford for 6 years. She was a member of the South Church in New Britain; was a former church Deaconess and enjoyed singing in the church choir. Louise traveled extensively, staying in many elder hostel's and was a member of the Appalachian Mountain Club.
