Lowell H. Barger Jr., 48, of Plainville, husband of Susan Bramhall Barger, died Friday July 20, 2007 at Bristol Hospital from injuries received in a motorcycle accident. Born in Hartford, son of Jeannette Audet Barger of New Britain and the late Lowell H. Barger Sr., he was a former New Britain resident, moving to Plainville 15 years ago. An avid motorcycle rider and Boston Red Sox fan, Lowell worked at Home Depot in Bristol for the past 13 years as night crew chief.

Besides his wife Susan and his mother Jeannette, Lowell is survived by a son Lowell H. Barger III; two daughters, Alicia C. Barger and Hannah E. Barger all of Plainville; a brother, Robert Barger and his wife Wendy of Dade City, FL; two sisters, Debra Nadeau and her husband Norman of Berlin, and Margaret Ziegenhagen and her husband Michael also of Berlin; several nieces and nephews.
