Lucille “Lucy” (Stamatis) Greos, 97, of New Britain, widow of Samuel L. Greos, passed away Wednesday (July 14, 2021) at the Hospital of Central CT. She was a graduate of Plainville High School, Class of 1942. Her husband Sam operated the St. Claire Confectionary on Main St in New Britain, where Lucy frequently assisted.
