Lucy Mae Harris Grzes, 92, of New Britain, wife of the late Frank W. Grzes, passed away Wednesday January 25, 2012 at Andrew House Healthcare in New Britain. Born in Laconia, NH, she was a former Hartford resident, moving to New Britain in 1959. A graduate of Laconia High School in 1937, Lucy was a waitress at the former Char-Far Restaurant in New Britain, then at the Surrey Restaurant in Berlin and later at the Italian Kitchen on the Berlin Turnpike, retiring in 1981.
