Lydia Muratori Poeta, 82, of New Britain, wife of the late Renzo Poeta, passed away Monday September 26, 2011 at the Hospital of Central Connecticut in New Britain. Born in New Britain, Lydia was the youngest of 5 children and was predeceased by her parents Egiziano and Evelina Amadori Muratori. A graduate of New Britain High School, class of 1946, she was formerly employed at Landers, Frary & Clark Company and then worked for 36 years at Fafnir Bearing Company, retiring in 1987.
