Marcel L. Beaudoin, 84, of Plainville, husband of Aline Cusson Beaudoin, died Sunday July 16, 2006 at New Britain General Hospital. Born in St. Valerien, Quebec, Canada, he was a former New Britain resident for 42 years, moving to Plainville in 1996. Marcel was employed at Fafnir Bearing Co. for over 20 years, retiring in 1986. He was a member of Our Lady of Mercy Church in Plainville; the Le Movement De La Rencontre; and was a former member of St. Maurice Church in New Britain.
