



## Margaret McGrath Corr Wagner

August 15, 1906 - December 18, 2003

Margaret McGrath Corr Wagner, 97, formerly of Berlin, died Thursday December 18, 2003 at Governor House in Simsbury. She was predeceased by her first husband James E. Corr in 1958 and her second husband Leander Wagner in 1978. Born in Hartford, she was raised in Simsbury and lived in the Berlin area for over 70 years. A graduate of Simsbury High School and Teachers College of Connecticut now CCSU, she received her Masters in Education from Trinity College. Margaret started teaching English in Berlin in 1926 and served as Dean of Students and Assistant Principal at Berlin High School until her retirement in 1971. She was a member of First Lutheran Church in New Britain; Berlin Education Association; National Education Association; the Retired Teachers Association; and the Timberlin Women's Association.

Surviving is her daughter, Margaret "Peggy" Veneziano and her husband Anthony of Wellfleet, Mass; two grandchidren, Sean Murphy of Portsmouth, NH and Kathleen Knight and her husband Julian of Providence RI; 2 step grandchildren, Anne Marie and Susan Veneziano; several nieces and nephews.
