



## Margot Mills Larson

August 7, 1946 - February 21, 2016

Margot Mills Larson, 69, of Attawan Beach, Niantic, the love of her husband Gary's life, slipped into the arms of God on Sunday February 21, 2016 at CT Hospice in Branford after an eight and a half year battle with Lung Cancer. Born in Sherbrook, Quebec, Canada, daughter of Aldea Rouleau Mills of Sherbrook, and the late James Mills, she came to the U.S. in 1969 and married Gary in 1973. They lived in Burlington until moving to Attawan Beach in 1999. Educated bilingually in Canada, she became Executive Secretary and Personal Assistant to Christopher Larson at Imprint/West Hartford News. She later became Personnel Director and Director of Facilities at Imprint. She then founded Management Alternative Consulting. In 2004, she formed KardasLarson Human Resource Consulting with Carol Kardas. Margot retired in January 2015. She authored two books, *Jump Start Your Life* and *Living with Cancer, A Journey of Hope*. Margot was former secretary of the Attawan Beach Association; former President of the Lake Garda Improvement Association and a former member of the Burlington Sewer Commission. She was president of several professional and women's organizations including the Human Resource Association of Central CT HRACC, the Human Resource Leadership Association of Eastern CT HRLA, Connecticut's Women in Healthcare Management and was a member of the Human Resource Dynamic Ladies. In her afterlife, she hopefully will be snorkeling in good health in the clear blue waters off her favorite island, St. John, USVI.

Besides her husband Gary and her 99 year old mother, she leaves two brothers, Bob and Lise Mills, Dick and Miriam Mills and a sister, Claire and Peter Bright as well as nieces and nephews, Alan and France, Jim and Helen, Christine and Norman and Michelle and Aaron, all of Canada, and many many cousins.
