Marjorie Wright Wenz, 89, of Plantsville, died Wednesday September 21, 2005 at New Britain General Hospital. Widow of Randall M. Wenz, who died September 24, 1978, she was a New Britain native until moving to Newington for 15 years, and then to Plantsville in 2001. Marjorie was a graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1933, and was employed at the Fafnir Bearing Company for over 10 years until her retirement in 1980. She was a member of St. Mark's Episcopal Church in New Britain and a member of the St. Elizabeth's Guild of the church.

Surviving are two sons, Randall K.
