September 1, 1919 - November 10, 2006

Martha Abrahamson Lewis, 87, of Kensington, widow of John Lewis, died unexpectedly Friday November 10, 2006 at her home. Born in New Britain, daughter of the late Luther and Agda Johnson Abrahamson, she lived in Kensington since 1951. Martha graduated from New Britain High School in 1938 and was an administrative secretary in the English Department at CCSU for 13 years, retiring in 1979. She was a member of the Kensington Congregational Church; the Book Club at the Berlin Free Library; and was a former member of the Monday Night Club in Kensington.

Surviving are two sons, Peter Lewis and his wife Laurie of Nantucket, Mass; and Robert Lewis and his wife Lisa of Southport; a daughter, Betsy Keller and her husband Alan of Cheshire; seven grandchildren, Robert and Jonathan Lewis; Moira and Peter Lewis; Megan, Alison, Kathryn Keller; two sisters-in-law, Vera and Grace Abrahamson, both of Kensington; three nieces and two nephews.
