Mary Gilberto Pizzuto, 96, of New Britain, beloved widow of James Pizzuto who died in 1978, died Friday May 21, 2004 at New Britain General Hospital. Born in the Bronx, New York, Mary has been a New Britain resident since 1925. She was employed at American Paper Goods in Kensington for 15 years until her retirement in 1959. Mary was a member of St. Ann's Church in New Britain; a member of the Ladies Guild and Wednesday Seniors Group of the church; a life member of Italia Fratallanza; was a member of the St. Sofia Society; the Ladies Auxiliary of Italian-American War Veterans; and was a former member and honoree of the Columbian Federation.
