



Melinda (Hausman) Baumgartner

November 21, 1945 - October 12, 2022

Melinda (Hausman) Baumgartner, 76, of South Windsor, passed away peacefully on Wednesday (October 12, 2022) at Vernon Manor in Vernon. A New Britain native and former Bristol resident, she moved to South Windsor in 2018. Melinda was a graduate of New Britain High School Class of 1963 and of Concordia College. She received her Master's Degree at CCSU. She worked at the Greater Hartford Chapter of the American Red Cross in Farmington for 16 years, and later at CCSU as a Secretary in the Anthropology Department for 11 years, until her retirement. Melinda was a member of St. Andrew's Lutheran Church in Bristol; the Plainville Choral Society; and was formerly active at Grace Lutheran Church in Plainville. Surviving is her son, Nathan Baumgartner of Manchester; a daughter, Christa Mallozzi and her husband Ralph of Stony Point, NY; two brothers, Rev. Robert Hausman of St. Paul, MN, and Frederick Hausman and his wife Nancy of New Bern, NC; three sisters, Adele Hausman of Fitchburg, MA, Eva Hausman and her companion Curt of Lockport, NY, and Barbara Hoekman and her husband Roland of New Bern, NC; four grandchildren, Katelyn and Dylan Baumgartner, and Megan and Grace Mallozzi; several nieces and nephews; and her former husband Rev. Willard Baumgartner of Cromwell.
