Michal Mazurkiewicz, 77, of Kensington, husband of Lynn Ahlquist, passed away peacefully, Sunday (March 8, 2026) at Yale New Haven Hospital. Born in Russia, Michal's family relocated to Poland. In search of a new life, his family later immigrated to the United States, first settling in Albany, New York with relatives before eventually making their home in New Britain, Connecticut and then Kensington, Connecticut in 1992. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of '69, he was employed as a Maintenance Mechanic at Kohler Mix Specialties in Newington, Connecticut for over 30 years.
