



## Mildred Sulliman Alvord

June 10, 1921 - November 8, 2011

Mildred Sulliman Alvord, 90, of Manchester, widow of Wesley P. Alvord, passed away Tuesday November 8, 2011 at her home. A New Britain native, she lived in Manchester since 1983. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1940, Mildred worked in the Publications Department at Pratt & Whitney Aircraft, East Hartford for 15 years, retiring in 1974. She was a member of Center Congregational Church in Manchester and the Questers Antique Group.
