Mildred Houser Pogue, 90, of West Hartford, died Sunday November 22, 2009 at the Hospital of Central CT in New Britain. She was born in Shelby, NC, on January 8, 1919, to Rufus Houser and Mariah Herndon. She was a graduate of Virginia State College in 1940. Mildred married Elbert Hugo Pogue on June 28, 1941. After he completed medical school and military service during WW II, they settled in Elizabeth, NJ, where Dr. Pogue practiced medicine until 1991. Mildred was predeceased by her husband of 57 years and by her daughter, Stephanie E. Pogue.

She is survived by her son, William H. Pogue M.D., a physician in New Britain, and his wife Dietra, as well as three grandchildren: Robert E. Pogue, Stephanie M. Pogue and Laurie E Pogue Rappa.
