Millicent "Millie" Gronback Amberger, 95, of Cromwell, passed away Tuesday December 15, 2009 at Covenant Village. She was the widow of Stephen J. Amberger, who died in 1990. Born in New Britain, she lived in Newington for 35 years, moving to Covenant Village in 1992. A graduate of New Britain High School, Class of 1934, she was a receptionist for Dr. Charles Wahlberg for 15 years and at Keeny Manufacturing in Newington until retiring in 1976. She was a member of the former Stanley Memorial Church in New Britain and was former church soloist and choir member at the church for 25 years.

Surviving are two brothers, George Gronback and his wife Lourde of Meriden; and Ronald Gronback and his wife Patricia of Wethersfield; several nieces and nephews. Besides her husband, she was predeceased by three brothers, Richard, Linus and Harry Gronback Jr.
