



Minnie "Eleanor" Hesse

April 11, 1910 - October 12, 2002

Minnie "Eleanor" Hesse, 92, of Cromwell, formerly of New Britain, died Tuesday October 11, 2002 at Middlesex Hospital. Born in New Britain, Eleanor lived in Newington for 20 years, moving to New Britain and finally moving to Cromwell where she was for the past 12 years. Eleanor was employed at the Emhart Corporation of Berlin in the Cost Accounting Department until her retirement in 1975. A longtime member of the South Congregational First Baptist Church in New Britain, where she was a former deacon and member of the choir. She was also a short-term volunteer missionary to American Baptist Churches in South India and the Philippians. Eleanor attended school in both New Britain and Newington and is a graduate of the Teachers College of Connecticut now CCSU.

She is survived by a sister, Louise K. Hesse of Cromwell, and was predeceased by a Step-Mother, Beda Dahlstrom Hesse.
