Friend, a pharmacist and owner of the former Lincoln Pharmacy, preceeded her in 1981. Born in Pittsburg, PA to John and Mary Louise Rattray England, she moved here from New York in 1944. Muriel was employed in the Safe Deposit Department of the New Britain National Bank for 23 years, retiring in 1980. She was a volunteer worker at Hartford Hospital, New Britain Memorial Hospital, the New Britain Public School System, Literacy Volunteers of America, retired senior volunteer program RSVP and at the former First Baptist Church, where she was a member for many years.
