



Nancy Furnivall Howe

April 2, 1929 - August 17, 2015

Nancy Furnivall Howe, 86, of New Britain, died Monday August 17, 2015 at The Connecticut Hospice in Branford. She was predeceased by her husband of 55 years, Ralph "Ted" Howe Jr. who died in 2008. Born in Hartford, daughter of the late, Maurice and Isabel Harbison Furnivall, she was a former West Hartford resident before moving to New Britain in 1953. A graduate of the Chaffee School in Windsor in 1946, she received her Bachelor's Degree in Psychology from Mt. Holyoke College. She was a member, former deacon and moderator of First Church of Christ, Congregational in New Britain. Nancy was active in numerous local community organizations. She was a founder and former board member of Mooreland Hill School, former member and Chairperson of Pathways/Senderos, and was a longtime member of the New Britain Junior League.
