Nils A. Erickson, 91, of New Britain, husband of Anne Bator Erickson, passed away Wednesday October 9, 2013 at Walnut Hill Care Center in New Britain. Born in Sunne, Sweden, he lived in New Britain most of his life. Nils was a graduate of E.C. Goodwin Technical School and was a former POW while serving in the US Army during World War II. He worked at the former Carling Switch, now Carling Technology in Plainville as a Tool & Die Maker for 25 years, retiring in 1987. Nils was a member of St. Joseph's Church in New Britain; New Britain VFW Post 511; The AARP Chapter in Newington; and was a former member of the Stanley Men's Club at Stanley Golf Course.
