



## Orestes M. Davey

November 2, 1922 - July 22, 2006

Orestes M. "Rusty" Davey, 83, of New Britain died Saturday July 22, 2006 at New Britain General Hospital. Born in Hartford, he lived in New Britain most of his life. A graduate of New Britain High School, class of 1939, he attended Yale University, served in the Army Air Corps during World War II, and received his Engineering Degree from the University of Connecticut. He was employed at Stanley Works in the research department where he held several patents. He retired in 1978 after more than twenty years with the company. Orestes was a member of St. George Greek Orthodox Church and was formerly affiliated with the Repertory Theater group. Surviving is his brother, Dr. Lycurgus M. Davey of North Haven; three nieces, Elizabeth Davey and her husband Paul Kwasniewski of Old Saybrook; Elaine Topodas and her husband Jonathan of Fairfax Station, VA.; and Georgia "Gigi" Davey of Kensington; two nephews, Micheal Davey and his wife Artemis of Alexandria, VA; and Peter Davey of Florida; several grandnieces and grandnephews. He was predeceased by two brothers, Polycrates Davey and an infant brother Alexander Davey. Funeral services are Tuesday 10 am at St. George Greek Orthodox Church, 301 West Main Street, New Britain, CT 06051. Burial with military honors will be in Fairview Cemetery.
