Patricia (Connelly) Beckius, 80, of Newington, wife of Kenneth Beckius, passed away Friday (August 25, 2023) at her home. Born in New Britain to the late Francis and Viola (Howe) Connelly, Pat graduated from St. Thomas Aquinas High School in 1961 and married her beloved husband Ken in 1968.

Pat worked for Connecticut General and Heublein in her younger years, and she and Ken raised their children, Andrew, Charles, and Kate, in Newington, where they made their home the past 49 years.

Pat had a lifelong love of Broadway shows and music, especially folk music. Of all the talented artists, Joan Baez was her shining star. Pat was a strong supporter of social justice causes. She worked hard to spread joy to those in her circle through her personal "card ministry," marking every birthday, anniversary, and holiday big or small with a greeting card, putting so much love into every handwritten correspondence and choosing just the right stamp. Whether card, text, or phone call, Pat could never keep it short, expressing how much she cared through thoughtful paragraphs (and emojis). Pat was grateful for the friendship and support she received through AA and for her 26 years of sobriety. A 32-year cancer survivor and a true Leo, Pat stayed positive and fought like a lion until the end.

Besides her husband Kenneth, she leaves two sons, Andrew Beckius and his wife Alice Johnson of Phoenix, AZ; and Charles Beckius and his wife Laura of Glastonbury; a daughter, Kate Beckius of Kensington; 5 grandchildren, Ryan, Heather, Steven, Mace and Laila; and extended family. She was predeceased by her sister Judy Lyons. We love you to the moon and back.
