Patricia Ann Lynch, 87, of New Britain, died Monday March 31, 2014 at Southington Health Care Center in Southington. She was born in New Britain, the daughter of the late Michael J. Lynch Jr., and Anna Hallinan Lynch. She attended St. Mary School, Mount St. Mary Academy and graduated from Teachers College of Connecticut now CCSU in New Britain. She received her Master's Degree from Fairfield University. Pat was employed by the New Britain Board of Education as an Elementary School Teacher for 40 years working at Lincoln, Holmes and Northend Elementary Schools. She was an active member of St Francis of Assisi Church since its founding, serving as a Eucharistic Minister, Parish Council member and Lector. Upon her retirement, Pat was a volunteer at the St. Francis of Assisi Middle School.
