Paul S. Passan, 86, of New Britain, husband of Beulah Tofano Passan, died Sunday September 29 in Cromwell. Son of the late Carmelo and Rose Passanisi, Paul was born in Waterbury and has been a lifelong New Britain resident. He served during WWII in the U.S. Merchant Marine. He is a member of Bethel Alliance Church in New Britain. A graduate of Teachers College in New Britain in 1948, he received a Masters Degree from Hillyer College in 1950. Paul was a Teacher in Rocky Hill from 1949 to 1960 and then as a Guidance Counselor at the Washington Middle School in Meriden until his retirement in 1980.

Besides his devoted wife Beulah, he is survived by a son, Noel P.
