Pauline M. Howard, 88, died Thursday July 11, 2002 in Santa Monica, California after a short illness. Born in Eddyville, Kentucky on August 3, 1913, she was the daughter of the late Earl and Beatrice Moneymaker.

She moved to Connecticut in 1929 and was a longtime resident of New Britain. For over 20 years, she owned and operated Howard Cleaners, Inc. with her late husband Walker Gullatt, until his death in 1953. She continued operating the business until 1958, when she moved to Birmingham, Alabama and married the late Hal W. Howard. In 2000, she moved to Santa Monica, California to be with her daughter.

Up until her death, Mrs. Howard was very active. She enjoyed her family and avidly followed current events. She also liked watching college football and professional basketball and rooted the LA Lakers and Crimson Tide to many victories.
