Peggy Duncan Sandquist, 90, of East Berlin, widow of Raymond Sandquist, passed away Wednesday January 9, 2013. Born in East Hartford, she was a longtime Berlin and East Berlin resident. Peggy graduated from Berlin High School Class of 1940 and worked for the State of Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles for over 25 years. A member of Berlin Congregational Church, she was a former church Deaconess and member of the church Women's Federation. She was the past Berlin Town Historian and was very active in the Berlin Historical Society.
