Peter Joseph Cloutier, 57, of New Britain, passed away Thursday (Nov. 17 2022) at the Hospital of Central Connecticut. A lifelong New Britain resident, he was son of Sandra (Sasiela) Cloutier Sultar of Sanibel Island, FL and Roger Cloutier and his wife Alexandra of Dallas, TX. Peter was predeceased by his maternal grandmother Nina H. Sasiela, maternal grandfather Joseph S.
